Dear Friends & Supporters,

can hardly believe how much progress Springmoor has made since March 2020. The beginning of that year was, of course, only the start of Covid's enormous impact on our industry, state, nation, and world. We have adjusted and have had the opportunity to rethink many aspects of life at our community. It is safe to say most of us have a new respect for preventing the spread of germs through hand washing and other strategies.

I am delighted that, slowly but steadily, we are returning staffing to pre-Covid levels. We have created new job definitions, provided pay raises, and implemented a variety of creative solutions to encourage folks to come back to work. Pay increases—on top of the very high inflation we saw in 2022 and continue to see in multiple areas—have reset some expense items that will have a lasting impact.

Writing about 2022 as it recedes in the rearview mirror encourages me to focus on new ideas and continue to develop innovative approaches to shape how Springmoor will develop in 2023 and beyond. As I look back at the past four decades, it is apparent that many things have changed and that serving residents is quite different than it was in the 1980s.

At the same time, the basic values, primary principles, and greatest strengths of the Springmoor community have remained consistent over the years. Members of the management team tend to concentrate on big picture areas such as programing and service packaging. However, as I walk around Springmoor and talk to residents and staff, I recognize that helping each resident live their best life depends largely on high-quality day-to-day interactions with staff and other residents.

Technology continues to change quickly and have a greater impact on how we communicate and complete daily tasks. All of us, including those over 65, have embraced a variety of forms of technology, and we want all residents to benefit from technology that enhances life at Springmoor.

Recently, two staff members with long tenure retired—one after 38 years and the other after more than 24 years. At the retirement functions honoring these individuals, it was rewarding to witness the tears, the emotions, and the amazing strength of the relationships that our employees have with each other. A passion for providing resident-centered care ties all staff together. Though some team members interact only infrequently, they are connected by their commitment to kindness and maximum effort on behalf of residents. The common twinkle in their eyes reveals a pride in their work that all share.

I stay very pleased with our marketing efforts. We have remained over 98% full for most of the years we have been open, and again in 2022, we added to our waitlist. We have championed the Continuing Care Retirement Community (CCRC) concept for many years. A licensed CCRC puts in place many components that may become necessary to folks as they age and change. What used to be an unfamiliar phrase to most is now almost common knowledge. Providing various levels of living options on one campus addresses preferences today, while covering needs in the future as they arise.

Thank you to all our board members, residents, family members, and staff for your tremendous love and support that make Springmoor the exceptional place that it is.

Dear Friends,

am proud to share that 2022 was an extremely busy and successful year for Springmoor, despite the long-lasting impact of the pandemic. As the health effects of Covid subsided, a workforce crisis emerged. The retirement living industry was hit hard, and health care and hospitality were the two industries with the most unfilled jobs during the crisis.

Most jobs at Springmoor and other retirement communities are included in these two categories: nurses, CNAs, housekeepers, transportation, concierge services, and dining services. I am happy to report, however, that we welcomed 167 new employees to the Springmoor family in 2022 and experienced a lower turnover rate than in 2021. This speaks volumes about our dedicated and tenured staff, who believe so intensely in our mission and are loyal to Springmoor.

Our marketing efforts were also successful. We welcomed 46 new residents to our Springmoor family, received deposits, and added future residents to our waitlist. This is a testament to our legacy of providing excellent quality of life for all residents for more than 38 years.



Our chaplains, life enrichment staff, and wellness team members are responsible for Pathways, and they provide the best services a resident could ever receive. I wanted to highlight two additional areas: Our Pathways program and staff promotions and achievements. In 2022, life enrichment created an outdoor concert series on our newly constructed stage. The series featured bluegrass and oldies bands and even a solo performance by a Springmoor staff member. Our chaplains continued their mission of spiritual wellness through reoccurring worship services, book studies, discussion groups, and community outreach to the greater Raleigh community.

We had two employees complete the North Carolina Administrator in Training Program, and both received their state and national Nursing Home Administrators License. One was promoted to Associate Director, and the other to Director of Home Care Services. Another employee graduated from the LeadingAge North Carolina Leadership Academy.

Lastly, several additional employees were promoted within the many departments at Springmoor. Providing opportunities for growth and advancement for Springmoor staff members is a significant part of our mission statement, and I am proud to say we lived this out in 2022.

I would like to express my sincere gratitude to residents, their family members, the Springmoor Board, and of course our staff, for all that you do to make Springmoor the best it can be.

Dear Friends,

his past year brought to fruition many hours of visioning and strategic planning on the path toward an updated Stewart Health Center on our campus. Over the course of the year, ideas and drawings finally gave way to brick and mortar. Much of the exterior work was completed, including a new overhang and entry way for Clayton Wing that will provide easier access for visitors and staff. Along with that entry, the footprint of the building was expanded to accommodate a new larger therapy space, as well as a corridor, with elevator, to connect the formerly "U" shaped hallways into a full circle.

The administrative offices were relocated to make way for a full demolition of their former area, to be reframed into an updated outpatient clinic space and therapy facility. Once complete, both areas will offer more convenient access for independent and health center residents alike.



In conjunction, the second floor space formerly occupied by therapy is being transformed into the updated office suite. A new conference room and updated offices for administrative nursing staff are highlights of this area.

This phase is the first step towards reshaping the building and pushing us forward with renewed focus on person-centered care. Construction will continue over the course of 2023, including resident rooms and dining areas. All this effort will result in a physical layout that facilitates our neighborhood model and allows residents to feel more at home in their surroundings. Staff will consistently work in the same neighborhood and "blend" roles to provide the best care for each individual and a nurturing, home-like environment within their neighborhood.


Rendering of New Lobby

n the fall of 2022, we completed the construction of a new outdoor stage for concerts and other activities related to our Pathways Resident Wellness Program. We christened the green space with a guitar performance by Cary Corley, our Stewart Health Center Administrator. Residents were excited to enjoy live music at our first wine and cheese social of the season.

Our "Happy Fall Y'all" event closely followed the social. Adult Supervision, a band featuring Springmoor resident Frank Roediger, delighted members of the community with a concert. Residents also enjoyed a Fall Concert Series each Saturday in October, followed by Pumpkin Fest, which featured entertainment, delicious catered food, and many pumpkin-themed items for sale.

Each of our fall events had over 100 residents in attendance. All enjoyed the beautiful weather, and the stage area continued to provide another flexible space in which to gather.

Springmoor has a rich history of music enthusiasts, as well as performances. We provide multiple opportunities every month for residents to enjoy live music. We also have many talented residents, and new groups and programs continue to evolve. Most recently, we added a new handbell choir called The Springmoor Ringers that is directed by resident Janet Carter. The group began practicing in the fall, and they were so advanced by December that they performed at one of our Christmas Vespers services.

Each month, residents receive a detailed calendar and can choose to participate in the events and activities that interest them most. Just a few of the opportunities we provide on a regular basis include visits to local museums, games like croquet and shuffleboard, our Life Writing Workshop, attending sporting events, going out for lunch or dinner, Drumming for Life, lectures on fascinating topics in our auditorium, day trips to points of interest outside of the Triangle, classes from painting to fused glass in our Meraki Arts Studio, dozens of exercise classes, and a wide range of spiritual offerings.

Health & Fitness Department

he wide variety of exercise classes and wellness programs we provide to residents are the core of the Health & Fitness Department. Our professional instructors taught 1,633 classes in 2022. Residents' total attendance reached 12,533. Participation increased by 7% from the previous year.

We continued to see growth in our personal training services. Residents have the option to pay for one-on-one services that our Pathways Health & Fitness Team offers. There was a 30% increase in the use of this service between 2021 and 2022.

We have yet to need a formal marketing campaign to promote personal training. Tremendous growth has come from word of mouth alone. As residents are satisfied with their progress, they spread the word, and more residents request personal training. The success of this aspect of our programming is evident; we have experienced 1,267% growth in participation since we began offering this service in 2018.

In 2022, we saw the return of two major events: the Annual Health & Wellness Fair and the Dementia Conference. The Annual Health & Wellness Fair provided residents and staff with free flu vaccinations, educational materials, fitness screenings, and raffle prizes. The total attendance for 2022's health fair was 202 residents and staff.

Springmoor's social workers, chaplains, out-patient clinic staff, and health and fitness director organize the Dementia Conference. We plan each conference with specific goals in mind, and the event provides current clinical and medical insights, caregiver resources, and personal testimonies. The 2022 conference was geared towards our residents' distinct needs and featured a keynote speaker from Duke University and the University of North Carolina Alzheimer's Disease Research Center (Duke/UNC ADRC).

The Health & Fitness team looks forward to more growth in 2023!

Spiritual Life on Campus

he longstanding chaplain role at Springmoor requires two full-time chaplains. As a component of the Pathways Resident Wellness Program, our chaplains provide spiritual leadership and support during the various occurrences of daily life of residents and staff. The chaplains also serve as liaisons with area churches, ministers, and funeral homes.

The chaplains provide pastoral support to all within our community, regardless of an individual's beliefs. The majority of our ministry is provided on an individual basis with residents and staff. We also take joy in planning and leading a variety of programming.

Sixty-two Springmoor residents died in 2022. The Chaplains respond to each death and offer end-of-life rituals, prayers, and bereavement support to the surviving family members and friends. The Chaplains will often preside or assist in the presiding of memorial services as well.


Mission

- To strive to meet its mission with such commitment to excellence that Springmoor Life Care Retirement Community continues to be one of the premier retirement communities in this region of the nation.


