Each year, as I prepare this Annual Report message, I strive to say something new. Yet my first thought is always the same—gratitude for all that Springmoor means and for the privilege of being part of it. I have been involved with the community for more than four decades, and this long connection remains one of the great honors of my life.



One of the blessings of my role is hearing many expressions of thanks. These words are a testament to the quiet, daily acts of service that define our community, from the dining team member who remembers a resident's favorite coffee sweetener to the caregivers in Stewart Health Center who bring comfort and dignity at life's most tender moments. The work of our dedicated staff sometimes goes unseen, but it is deeply felt. Together, they create the culture of service that makes Springmoor special.

I was here when my parents, board members, our original residents—the Pioneers—and our first employees were establishing the Springmoor standard. Across campus, we continue to replace and upgrade furniture, artwork, elevators, air conditioning systems, and other important infrastructure so we do not fall behind and later have to play catch-up.

Also in 2025, we continued our multi-year investment in significant physical upgrades to Stewart Health Center, home to our licensed assisted living and skilled care beds. Having known the Stewarts well, I am confident they would be proud of these improvements. The health center bears their name not because of a monetary gift, but in recognition of their tireless service and lasting impact on Springmoor.

The past year was one of tremendous growth for the leaders of our community. Executive Director Brad Dilday and Assistant Executive Director Jessica Pagan have come into their own in confidence, effectiveness, and stride, and they are continuing to scale new heights regarding the services we offer.

We welcomed many new residents, some of whom followed in the footsteps of a loved one who once called Springmoor home. Other new residents were first introduced to our community when they visited as volunteers. I have personally enjoyed welcoming former teammates, coworkers, and mentors as they begin a new chapter on our campus. It is rewarding to see people who first knew Springmoor through visits, friendships, or family connections later choose our community for themselves.

Springmoor has concluded another highly successful year, distinguished by regional recognition and robust growth across all key performance indicators. From securing prestigious industry awards to expanding our prospective resident pipeline, the Marketing Department has effectively strengthened Springmoor's position as a premier retirement destination in the Triangle area.

A **highlight** of the year was Springmoor being named the "Best Retirement Community in Raleigh" by *Midtown Magazine*. Our team was formally honored at the Annual Diamond Awards in February 2026, a testament to our commitment to excellence and our standing within the local community.

We continued to prioritize educational outreach as a cornerstone of our growth strategy:

OLLI Partnership:

As proud sponsors of the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at North Carolina State University, we facilitated an educational seminar on retirement options in the Triangle for over 40 attendees.

Regional Engagement:

Our team conducted targeted presentations at St. James Church in Wake Forest and the Wake Forest Senior Center, broadening our reach into key neighboring demographics.

The Marketing Department remains dedicated to cultivating meaningful relationships and maintaining the momentum established over the past year. As we look toward the future, we remain focused on strategic growth, community enrichment, and upholding the award-winning standards that define the Springmoor experience.



The waitlist grew by **102**,
bringing the total to **423**.

Springmoor's value proposition continued to resonate strongly with prospective residents:

New Residents:

We welcomed 61 new residents across 42 units. Notably, 25 of these residents opted for unit upgrades, reflecting a demand for high-end, customized living spaces.

Waitlist Expansion:

The waitlist grew by 102 new additions this year, bringing the total to 423 active memberships.

Lead Generation:

The Marketing Team maintained a high volume of engagement, conducting over 700 personalized tours for prospective residents.

Our targeted event strategy continues to yield high conversion rates:

Lunch and Learn Series:

We hosted two sessions for 60 total prospects, directly resulting in 8 new waitlist memberships.

Seasonal Presentations:

Two fall presentations engaged over 30 attendees, further nurturing our lead pipeline.

Waitlist Engagement:

We observed a significant increase in waitlist member participation in on-campus wellness and enrichment programs, fostering early integration into the Springmoor community.

Program Highlights

ACCOMPLISHMENTS 2025:

Spiritual Life on Campus

Our two full-time chaplains nurture a culture of spiritual and psychosocial well-being. The chaplain role has been a longstanding component of the Pathways Resident Wellness Program, which provides spiritual support, pastoral care, and counseling to residents, families, caregivers, and staff in need, always honoring their diverse belief systems.

We provide spiritual programming to residents through individual and group counseling, as well as support groups. In addition to spiritual growth issues, topics include caregiving, health, aging, end-of-life, and bereavement. We also plan and lead a variety of worship services each week.

Much of our ministerial work occurs in the “quiet moments” and is carried out individually, as we

intentionally respond to the unique needs of residents and staff. We “walk alongside” the members of our community as they address anxiety, health challenges, and spiritual questions. Beyond scheduled programs, the chaplains provide individual spiritual counseling for residents wrestling with a difficult diagnosis, families making end-of-life decisions, and staff members experiencing burnout and compassion fatigue.

The chaplains assist with Newcomers Orientation to help new residents transition to Springmoor. We also work closely with the Social Work Team, assist with interns, and participate in continuing education.



Overview of Grief & Bereavement Services

In 2025, we honored the lives of 56 residents who passed away. Our team provided a structured and compassionate response to each death, offering:

End-of-Life Rituals: Provided prayers and presence for dying residents and immediate bereavement support for surviving family, friends, and affected staff.

On-Site Memorials: Assisted families in planning and presiding over memorial services held on site, allowing the entire community, neighbors, and staff to grieve and honor the departed.

Specialized Support for Residents: Offered the Spiritual Care End of Life (EOL) Choices Series “Planning for a Good Death” and the 5-week “Coping with the Holidays” grief support group, as well as annual bereavement services.

Targeted Support for Navigating Life Transitions & Health Challenges

We lead regularly scheduled support groups to provide confidential spaces for processing challenges such as declining health that are often related to aging:

Changes Group: A monthly space for processing the emotional impact of transition.

Connections Group: A bi-monthly discussion group for spiritual growth and communal sharing.

Dementia Caregiver Support Group: A vital resource for spouses navigating caring for a loved one with cognitive decline that directly addresses the high levels of stress and grief experienced by caregivers.

Accessible Worship & Spiritual Nurture

Recognizing mobility and health issues are significant barriers for many, we ensure spiritual care is accessible to everyone, regardless of their physical location or condition.

Beyond the Auditorium: Every other week, we bring worship directly to residents in the Stewart Health Center (SHC), as well as to the Seay Wing (Memory Care) each month. We adapt these services to the needs of the attendees, using familiar hymns, shorter liturgies, and sensory engagement. We also offer worship in The Pointe (formerly Supportive Living) every other week.

Hybrid Ministry: Live-streaming our Sunday Vespers service on our in-house TV channel makes it possible for residents who are unable to leave their rooms to remain part of the worshiping community.

Worship Services

Vespers Worship Service: Offered in the auditorium every Sunday at 7 pm, this service is also streamed on an in-house Springmoor TV channel.

Special Seasonal and Holy Day Observances: These include Epiphany, Ash Wednesday, Lent, Holy Week (Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday Tenebrae Service, and Easter), Pentecost, Thanksgiving, Advent, Christmas Lessons and Carols highlighting musical volunteers, Hanukkah candle lighting and evening prayers, and Kwanzaa candle lighting and prayers.

Communion Worship: We coordinate weekly communion worship with Catholic, Episcopal, and Methodist churches.

For Staff: The chaplains offer Staff Chapel each week. We also provide an Annual Memorial Service for the community, as well as an Annual Memorial Service for SHC staff. We provide staff debriefing after sudden employee deaths.

It is our joy to serve the residents and staff of Springmoor. Whether through an epic Monday Movie Matinee or a quiet debriefing session for staff after a loss, our goal remains the same: to be a calming presence and a sign of hope in every corner of this community.

Education, Support, & Fellowship

Book & Bible Study: Our Lenten Book Study was of *The Grace of Les Misérables*. Our Advent Book Study focused on *Angels of Christmas: Hearing God's Voice in Advent*. We also provided a 6-week Bible study on the Gospel of Luke.

Additional Groups: These include the Monthly Men's breakfast led by Chaplain Jim Rogers, Centering Prayer (meets weekly in the Chapel), and the Chaplain Monday Movie Matinee. We also presented *Combating Loneliness through Community* with social worker Sue Koehler.

Our Caring Circle is held bi-monthly in both North Village & South Village. Residents who are mental health professionals, trained Stephen Ministers, and hospice volunteers lead the group.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Our spirit of care extends beyond our walls. In 2025, the Chaplains coordinated significant food donations to Parkwood Food Hub and the Interfaith Food Shuttle.
